

NATIONAL ANTI-CORRUPTION STRATEGY STEERING COMMITTEE

Considering the multiple actors in the implementation of the strategy, it is important to have in place a well defined arrangement with the appropriate level of political authority to coordinate the implementation process and ensure that all state and non-state institutions fulfill their share of responsibilities. This role will be performed by a Steering Committee under the leadership of a chairman appointed by the President. The primary mandate of the Committee is to lead and oversee the implementation of the National Anti-Corruption Strategy.

Membership of the Committee will be drawn from the various Pillars of Integrity and will also include representative of all the political parties in Parliament. The work of the Committee will be coordinated by the Anti-Corruption Commission through its National Anti-Corruption Strategy Implementation Coordination Unit.

They will serve for a term of two and half years until the NACS mid-term review is conducted and their tenure may be renewed.
